To create an inclusive learning spaces for street and out-of-school youngsters in Africa, empowering them through rehabilitation, education, and vocational training to break the cycle of poverty

The Problem We Are Solving

The harsh reality of street life and the growing number of out-of-school youngsters expose them to abuse, disease, addiction, and crime. Stigma and exclusion rob them of opportunity, trapping them in cycles of poverty with no access to education, support, or a pathway to a better future.



From the Streets to the Soil: Football for Agripreneur



1. At AKHIN Africa, we believe that transformation begins with trust and sometimes, trust begins with a football.

2. Through our Football for Agripreneur initiative, presented earlier to Beyond Sport, we have successfully rehabilitated 40 homeless youngsters by combining the healing power of sport with hands-on agricultural training.

3 These youngsters once trapped in cycles of addiction, violence, and theft are now cultivating maize, cassava, vegetables, and raising poultry.

4. This not only reduces the cost of food at our centre but has also increased food availability in our surrounding community.

5. More than crops have grown. These young people are now learning to read, write (in both English and their mother tongues), solve basic math problems, and understand the principles of farming. Football has become a gateway teaching discipline, teamwork, and resilience. It has turned pain into power, and hopelessness into productivity.



Building an Inclusive Community Through Agriculture



This is what an inclusive community looks like where value replaces judgment, and contribution earns dignity.

At AKHIN Africa, we're not just ending homelessness we're planting hope and growing acceptance.

In February 2025, we rescued homeless youngsters. Today, their hands are feeding community that once walked past them. Through Football for Agripreneur, these young people have turned their pain into purpose.

What began as a rehabilitation program using football to teach discipline, literacy, and life skills has grown into a movement in agriculture. Now actively cultivating maize, cassava, vegetables, and poultry, their efforts are reducing hunger and boosting food security in our local area.

But beyond the crops, something even greater has taken root: acceptance. Our community has not only welcomed these youths but now proudly supports them—buying their farm products, offering encouragement, and seeing them for who they are becoming, not where they came from. The stigma of homelessness is giving way to respect and belonging.



Opening Minds: Literacy for a Brighter Future



At AKHIN Africa, we believe education is a powerful tool for transformation especially for homeless youngsters who have long been denied the opportunity to learn.

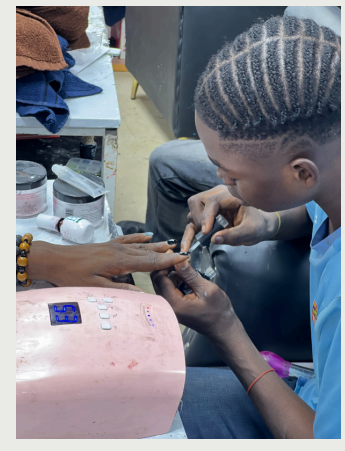
As part of our 18-months training program, we have officially launched literacy and basic mathematics classes for all participants. Through bilingual teaching in both English and their mother tongues, we are helping these young people build strong language skills, reconnect with their identity, and prepare for broader opportunities.

In addition, they are learning essential mathematics, addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division. skills they will need for daily life, financial independence, and future vocational paths. This is more than learning to read and count; it's about restoring dignity, unlocking potential, and breaking the cycle of illiteracy.

To continue this life-changing work, we are calling on individuals, institutions, and education-focused partners to support scholarships for our learners. With your help, we can equip every participant with the education they need to thrive beyond the streets. Together, let's build a future where no child is left behind.

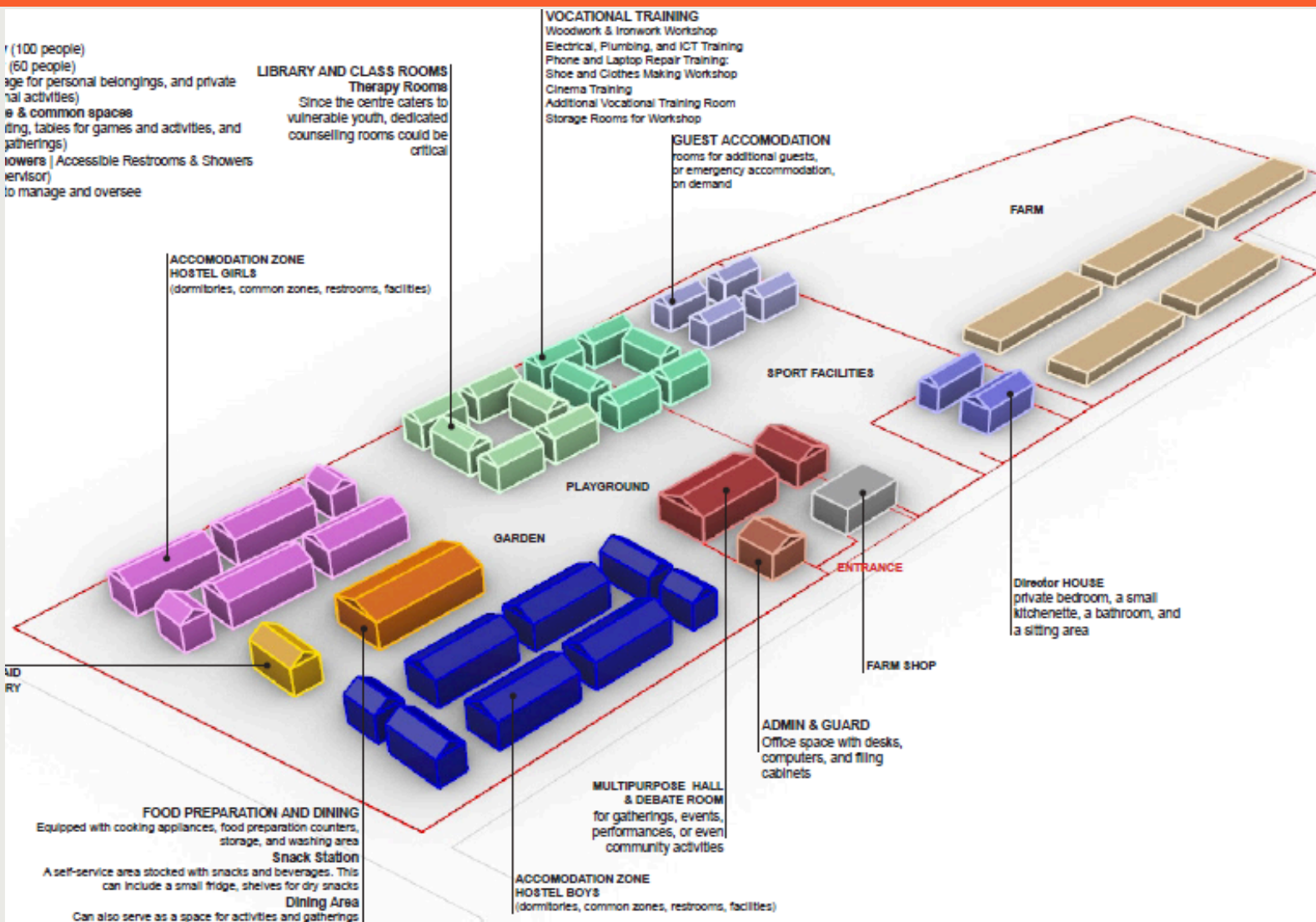

These skills are not just hobbies. They are income-generating tools, outlets for healing, and bridges to reconnect with society. Whether it's a young boy learning to tell his story through film or a girl learning to skate and dream again, the impact is clear: they are no longer just surviving they are growing.

OUR FUTURE INCLUSIVE HOME

Thanks to generous support from the OSV Foundation and individual contributions during the founder's visit to Europe. This funding was allocated to develop a sustainable community on a 37,000-square-meter piece of land.

The vision for this community is to foster sustainability and self-reliance. We aim to:

- Generate 70% of the food consumed within the community.
- Produce 60% of our electricity through renewable energy sources.
- Provide 100% of the community's water needs as clean and drinkable.

The village is designed to accommodate a maximum of 200 residents, including both physically able and disabled participants who are homeless and in need of shelter. The primary purpose of this community is to offer a safe space for self-development, empowering residents to rebuild their lives and achieve independence.
