Our Mission

To create an inclusive learning spaces for street and out-of-school youngsters in Africa, empowering them through rehabilitation, education, and vocational training to break the cycle of poverty

The Problem We Are Solving

The harsh reality of street life and the growing number of out-of-school youngsters expose them to abuse, disease, addiction, and crime. Stigma and exclusion rob them of opportunity, trapping them in cycles of poverty with no access to education, support, or a pathway to a better future.



WHEN THE HOMELESS DECIDED TO BUILD THEIR HOMES











I once dreamed of a village where the homeless could come together, build their own homes, and create a community of hope. When I shared this dream with some of our participants, their eyes lit up: "This is a good idea, I want to be part of it," they said.

We had no land, not even a single plot to start with, but we held on to hope. Then in 2024, O'Shaughnessy Ventures Fellowship believed in our story and gave us \$10,000. We put it to work, and in 2025, they entrusted us with a full fellowship grant.

Today, that burning dream is becoming real: AKHIN Village, a community built by the homeless for the homeless, where they can discover, develop, and explore their talents.

But we are not there yet. We still need to build our training space, sports arena, and farming equipment is needed for a sustainable system. Would you want to be part of this project?

This year alone, we reached over 50 youngsters through our street sports outreach. We have seen real behavioural change and stronger commitment to learning among them.






AKHINS ARE BACK TO SCHOOL







At AKHIN, we believe that every child deserves a second chance, not just to survive, but to learn, grow, and thrive. After rehabilitation, each youngster in our care makes a choice: some decide to return to school, while others choose to pursue vocational skills. But one thing remains nonnegotiable—every child must learn to read, write, and acquire basic numeracy skills.

For those who choose formal education, we support them in re-enrolling, from primary school up to university level. For those who prefer vocational training, we ensure they are equipped with literacy and numeracy first, so they can confidently proceed in their chosen path.

So far, we have successfully reintegrated youngsters across different levels of education—from university down to primary school, proving that no dream is too small, and no future is out of reach.



OUR FUTURE INCLUSIVE HOME

Thanks to generous support from the OSV Foundation and individual contributions during the founder's visit to Europe. This funding was allocated to develop a sustainable community on a 37,000-square-meter piece of land.

The vision for this community is to foster sustainability and self-reliance. We aim to:

- Generate 70% of the food consumed within the community.
- Produce 60% of our electricity through renewable energy sources.
- Provide 100% of the community's water needs as clean and drinkable.

The village is designed to accommodate a maximum of 200 residents, including both physically able and disabled participants who are homeless and in need of shelter.

The primary purpose of this community is to offer a safe space for self-development, empowering residents to rebuild their lives and achieve independence.


