# FOOT BALL TOURNAMENT


We organized a street football tournament in Ibadan, which provided us with the opportunity to bring together homeless youngsters. Through this event, we were able to introduce our project to the participants. Among the participants, we identified 20 individuals who displayed a strong willingness to participate, and we awarded them scholarships to join our one-year residential training program.

# MEDICAL TEST AND VACCINATION



All participants underwent comprehensive medical examinations, including tests for Malaria, Typhoid, HIV/AIDS, Hepatitis, and Tuberculosis at a hospital. These assessments provided us with a clear understanding of the participants' medical conditions, enabling us to determine the appropriate treatments required for each individual. Additionally, all participants received Hepatitis vaccinations, and they were all covered by medical insurance for one year.

# REHABILITATION THROUGH SPORT AND STORYTELLING



The AKHIN FOUNDATION embarked on a transformative journey to rehabilitate participants by combining the power of sports and storytelling. This innovative approach aimed not only to empower but also inspire individuals on their path to recovery and growth.

1. Sport as a Catalyst: We recognised the potential of sports as a tool for physical, mental, and emotional rehabilitation. Through organised sports activities, participants developed essential life skills such as teamwork, discipline, and resilience. These skills were crucial in helping them rebuild their lives.


